

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a public hearing to be held before the Plan Commission of the Village of Lake Barrington as follows:

HEARING DATE AND TIME: February 25, 2010 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the agenda permits.

PLACE OF HEARING: Village of Lake Barrington Village Hall, 23860 Old Barrington Road, Lake Barrington, Illinois.

NATURE OF HEARING: The Petitioner is requesting consideration of a petition for a special use permit to operate a judo school at 28147 Commercial Avenue, Unit 4, Lake Barrington, Illinois. The subject property is located in the M Manufacturing and Industrial Zoning District. Section 8-4-6(C), "M Manufacturing and Industrial District", of Chapter 4 of Title 8 of the Village of Lake Barrington Village Code, allows a school in an M District, but only if such a Special Use is approved by the Board of Trustees.

COMMON ADDRESS OF PROPERTY: 28147 Commercial Avenue, Unit 4, Lake Barrington, Illinois.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY:

Lot 38 in Lake Barrington Industrial Subdivision, Unit #2, Being a Subdivision of Part of Sections 21, 22, 27, and 28, Township 43 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, According to the Plat Thereof Recorded March 14, 1968 as Document Number 1371277 in Book 44 of Plats, Page 52, in Lake County Illinois.
